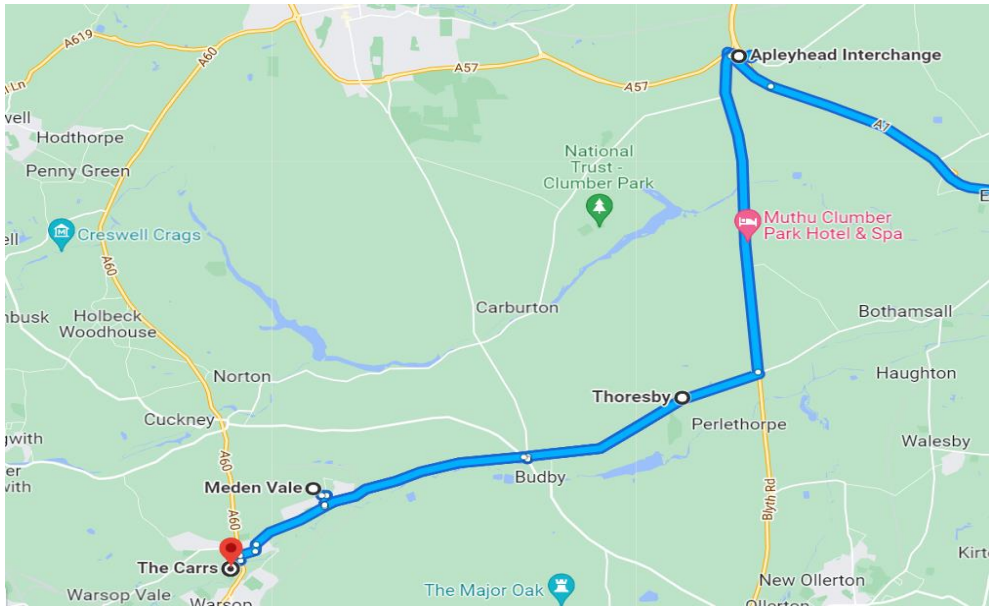


## DIRECTIONS TO WARSOP CARNIVAL (all traffic).

These directions will serve both stallholders and the general public who are travelling from outside the district, by road, to the carnival.

They are designed to avoid Warsop town-centre to minimise congestion and provide the best approach to the event site.

*In general, you are heading to the market town of Warsop, Mansfield, Notts - The Carrs recreation field by the river Meden (NGO OSF).*



#### A1 (from the South):

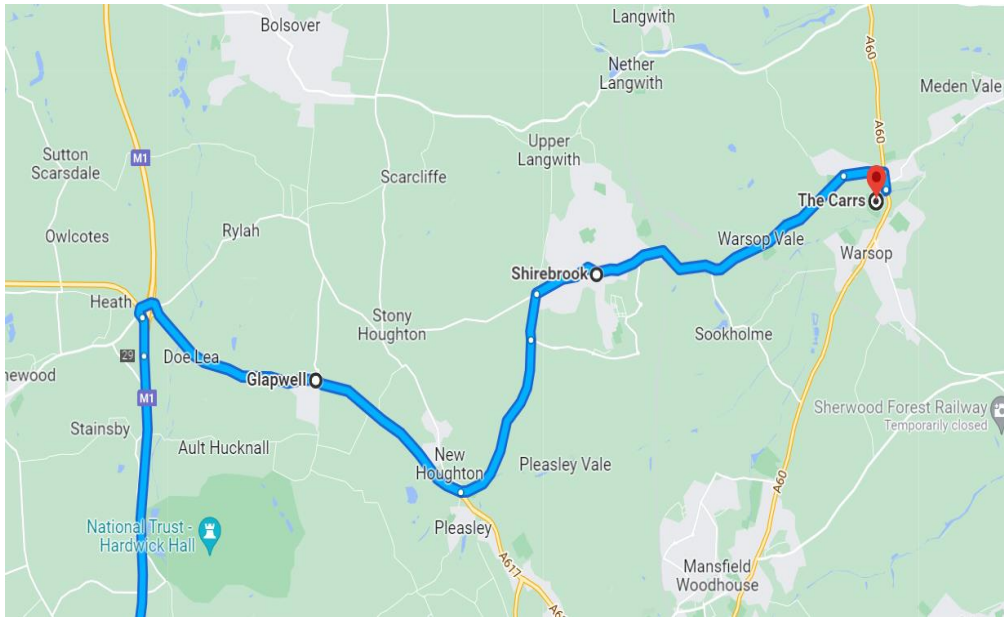
- Take the B6387 exit signposted Retford/Ollerton.
- After 500 feet, at the T junction, turn left onto B6387 towards Ollerton.
- After 1.5 miles, turn right onto Main St. towards Bothamsall - drive through the village (please be aware that this road has a weight restriction of 7.5T. Larger vehicles will need to use the Apleyhead Interchange at Worksop).
- After 2 miles, at the roundabout, continue straight onto Netherfield Lane (2nd exit signposted Thoresby).

#### A1 (from the North):

- Take the slip-road at Worksop (Apleyhead Interchange).
- At the roundabout, go right round and over the A1 then take the first exit onto Blythe Road (A614) signposted Ollerton.
- After 4 miles, at the roundabout, take the third exit onto Netherfield Road, signposted Thoresby.

#### Then (both routes):

1. After 2.5 miles, at the mini-roundabout, take the first exit (left).
2. After 150 feet, at the second mini-roundabout, take the second exit (right).
3. After 300 feet, turn left onto Netherfield Lane (signposted Meden Vale).
4. Stay on Netherfield Lane for approx. 3 miles which will take you through Meden Vale (30mph).
5. Netherfield Lane then bends to the left and becomes Coggins Lane for approx. 500 feet.
6. Coggins lane then turns sharp right to become Eastlands Lane.
7. After 0.2 miles, at the T-Junction facing the church, turn left towards Warsop.
8. After 200 feet, the entrance to the event field is on your right (take care turning in).



M1 (J29 Heath Interchange) - from the South:

- Take the slip road at Junction 29.
- At the top of the slip-road, at the roundabout, take the 5th exit towards Mansfield (A617 - Chesterfield Road).

M1 (J29 Heath Interchange) - from the North:

- Take the slip road at Junction 29.
- At the top of the slip-road, at the roundabout, take the 2nd exit towards Mansfield (A617 - Chesterfield Road).

Then (both routes):

1. Drive through Doe-Lea, Bramley Vale and up 'The Hill' through the village of Glapwell.
2. After 3.8 miles, at the roundabout, take the second exit onto Common Lane (B6407) towards Shirebrook.
3. After 0.4 miles, at the roundabout, take the first exit and stay on Common Lane (B6407) towards Shirebrook.
4. After 0.3 miles, at the T-Junction, turn right to stay on B6407 (Now called Main Street).
5. Drive down the hill into Shirebrook and after 2 miles, at the T-Junction, Turn right onto Station Road (still B6407).
6. Drive out of Shirebrook, over the two humped bridges.
7. Stay on B6407, drive through Warsop Vale (1 mile - B6407 is now called Carter Lane) and on to Church Warsop (a further 1.5 Miles).
8. Drive through Church Warsop (B6407 changes to B6031, Bishops Walk) to the T-Junction at the side of the church (which is on your right).
9. Turn right onto the A60 signposted Mansfield.
10. After 500 feet, the entrance to the event field is on your right (take extra care turning in).

Please note: As you approach the site entrance there is likely to be heavy traffic - including large vehicles queueing to enter the site and quite possibly a certain amount of congestion on the A60 as well as an increase in pedestrian traffic locally.

*Please be prepared to show your booking confirmation on request as you arrive.*

**Note:** the above entrance also serves as the entrance to the hard-standing, disabled parking area for blue-badge holders.

*Please be prepared to show your blue-badge on request as you arrive.*

For members of the public who arrive by car to attend the event (none stallholders and none blue-badge holders), the entrance to the main public carpark is on the right, several hundred feet further along the A60 (over the river Meden, towards Warsop). Again, there is likely to be queues at the carpark entrance causing some congestion on the A60. There will also be an increase in pedestrian traffic - so please take extra care when approaching this area.
